In continuation of Board's letters of even number dated 1.12.2008
and 29.12.2010, it is clarified that the higher rates of road mileage prescribed
for 'X' and 'Y' class cities would be admissible for transfers within 'X' and 'Y'
class cities; 'X' to 'Y' class cities and vice-versa; and from 'X'/'Y' class cities to
'Z' class cities and vice-versa. In all other cases of transfers within 'Z' class
cities, the rates prescribed for 'Z' class cities shall be admissible.
