

Record Note of Discussions held by Adviser(Accounts) with AIRF on 14.05.2015 on PNM/AIRF Item No.40/2012: Earmarking of posts for promotion of Non-appendix 3 IREM qualified Accounts Assistants in the merged cadre of Sr.SO(A/Cs) and SO(A/Cs).

It was explained to the Federation that 5% of the posts of SO(A/Cs) is same as worked out with 1% of the merged cadre strength of SO(A/Cs) and Sr.SO(A/Cs). As such, any alteration in the earmarked posts for Non-qualified staff in merged cadre is not considered desirable.

However, Federation requested to at least marginally increase the existing percentage (i.e. 1%).
